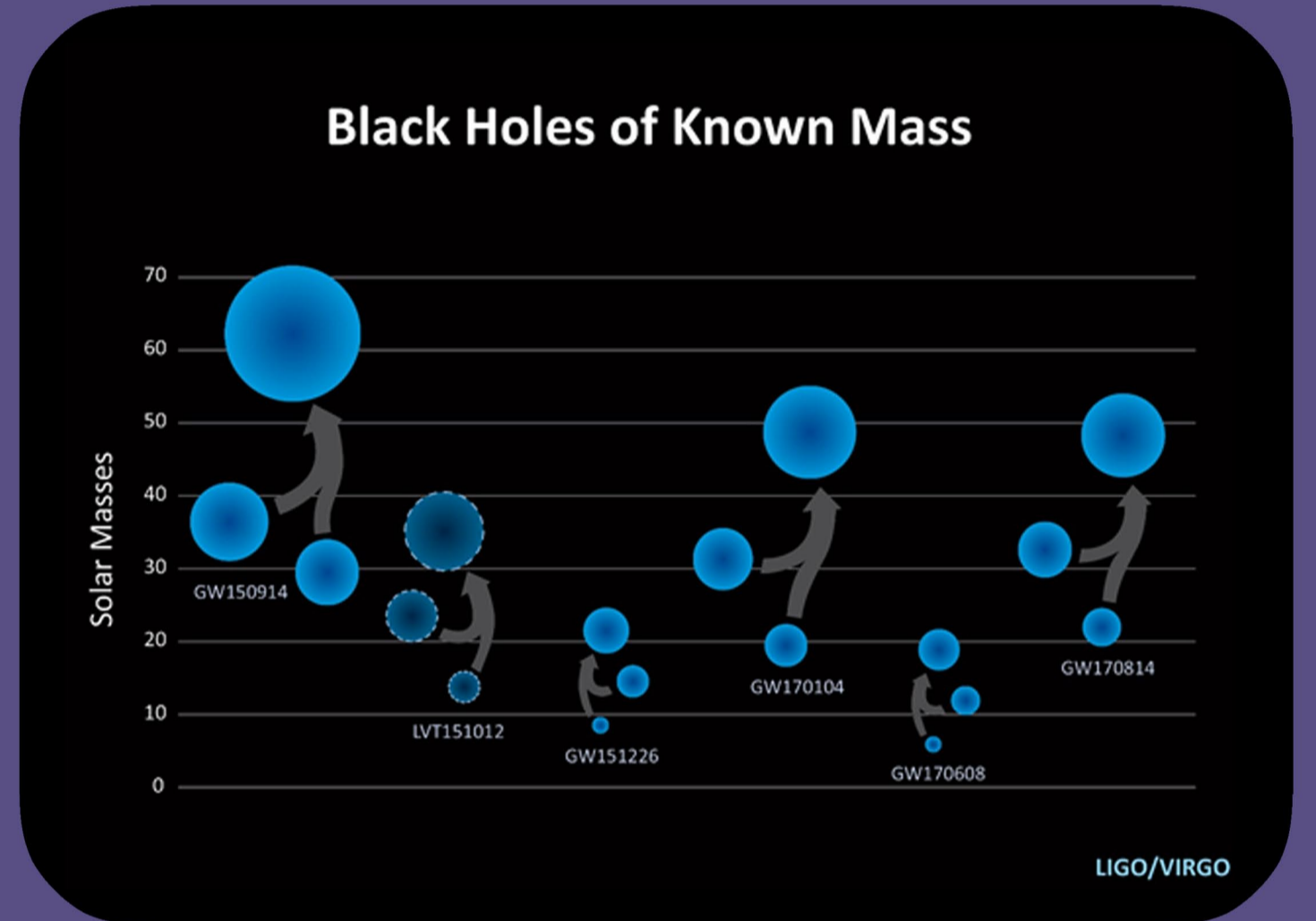
Ubiquitous Black Holes and Gravity in the 21st Century
